

KH3 – Covid-19 Guidelines for Hares – 24/09/20

Location of trail

1. Use public open spaces.
2. Avoid narrow footpaths.
3. Minimise obstacles that require surface contact (e.g. gates/stiles).
4. Do not use private land without express permission from all owners.

On the trail

1. Fishhooks – **only lay if and when** there is sufficient space to allow for social distancing between those on the fishhook and the rest of the hashers.
2. Check backs – permitted but ensure social distancing can be maintained.
3. Hash halts – only have these if they are required for safety (e.g. crossing a railway track) and social distancing can be maintained.

Hash briefing

1. If On sec is not present, make a record of all attendees. Ensure the name and contact number is taken for anyone who is not a regular hasher/not named. Email the record to Roxanne within 24 hours – cmercanto@gmail.com
2. Remind hashers to maintain social distancing at all times during the hash.
3. Remind hashers that they run at their own risk.
4. Remind hashers that if they develop Covid-19 symptoms or are required to self-isolate at any time within 14 days of a hash, they must notify Roxanne or other member of the Mismanagement without delay.

Sweetie stops

1. Remind hashers to maintain social distancing.
2. You are not required to provide sweets. If you do wish to bring sweets for distribution, you must be able to distribute without contact – e.g. using tongs. If sweets are individually wrapped, hashers must keep hold of their own rubbish and take it back to the car with them. No collection of rubbish by the hare.

Award the Boris Forfeit

1. Instead of Soft Bertie, award the Boris Forfeit. The forfeit must be something that the person does or wears at the next hash. For example, a forfeit could be that the hasher has to wear their underpants over their running tights/ wear a silly hat.
2. No forfeit must involve contact between people or compromise Covid safety/security.

Trash

1. This can be awarded but must be sent electronically to Roxanne for distribution.

General

1. Recommended that you carry hand sanitiser and (in case of emergency) a mobile phone.
